Pray for God to guide your family together.</p>	<p>LUKE 2:11 How was Jesus a part of God’s plan?</p>	<p>Make a plan for a way you can show someone else in your family how much you care about them this week.</p>	<p>Plan the perfect night for your family. Set a date for your plan! READ TOGETHER: Jeremiah 29:11 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?</p>
<p>WEEK 3 -----</p> <p>Jesus is the Son of God. What does this mean for me?</p>	<p>READ TOGETHER: John 3:16 Why did God send His Son?</p>	<p>Make a decree about your day and share with the family (like the angel did with Mary).</p>	<p>LUKE 2:11 Did God have to send His Son?</p>	<p>Think about something God is calling you to do that is a little scary. Pray together as a family for courage like Mary’s.</p>	<p>Share about a time you’ve stepped out in faith. READ TOGETHER: Luke 1: 35-38 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?</p>
<p>WEEK 4 -----</p> <p>Jesus was born to rescue. What does this mean for me?</p>	<p>READ TOGETHER: 2 Corinthians 5:21 How are we able to be the righteousness of God?</p>	<p>Pick your favorite Christmas worship songs. Spend time together praising God for sending His Son.</p>	<p>LUKE 2:11 Why do you think Jesus came as a baby?</p>	<p>Make a special family dessert to welcome baby Jesus. Say a prayer of thanks to God for His birth!</p>	<p>Make a list of things to glorify God like the sheperds in v. 20. READ TOGETHER: Luke 2:1-20 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?</p>
<p>WEEK 5 -----</p> <p>Jesus is King. What does this mean for me?</p>	<p>READ TOGETHER: Daniel 7:13-14 What’s different about Jesus’ kingdom?</p>	<p>Take turns being king of the family for the day. Who’s the best “ruler”?</p>	<p>LUKE 2:11 How can we thank Jesus for being our King and Savior?</p>	<p>Think of a family friend that might not know Jesus as King of their life. Talk about a way to share the good news with them!</p>	<p>Create your own North Star to put up at home as a reminder to always seek Jesus. READ TOGETHER: Matthew 2:1-12 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?</p>
