<p><b>WEEK 2</b> -----</p> <p>Jesus teaches us to care for others. What does this mean for me?</p>	<p><b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Philippians 2:4 How can you show others that they are important?</p>	<p>Brainstorm ways you can show your neighbors that they are loved.</p>	<p><b>1 PETER 5:7</b> How can we care deeply about others the way God cares about us?</p>	<p>Put family members' names in a hat. Each person chooses someone to deliberately show God's love to this week.</p>	<p>Pack a care kit to keep in your car and give to bless others in need. <b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Luke 10:25-37 <b>DISCUSS:</b> What does this teach us about God?</p>
<p><b>WEEK 3</b> -----</p> <p>Jesus cares about our priorities. What does this mean for me?</p>	<p><b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Phillipians 3:8 What should be our top priority?</p>	<p>Play a game of "Would You Rather ..." to learn about your family members' priorities.</p>	<p><b>1 PETER 5:7</b> Whom should we go to first with our anxieties?</p>	<p>Generate a family priority list. Pray over it and make sure it aligns with God and His Word.</p>	<p>Ask everyone in the family to list one family activity they want to do by the end of the month. <b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Luke 12:13-21, 32-34 <b>DISCUSS:</b> What does this teach us about God?</p>
<p><b>WEEK 4</b> -----</p> <p>Jesus welcomes all. What does this mean for me?</p>	<p><b>READ TOGETHER:</b> John 13:34 What command does Jesus give us?</p>	<p>Work together to make a welcome sign.</p>	<p><b>1 PETER 5:7</b> Whom does Jesus care for?</p>	<p>Bring baked goods to someone in your neighborhood to help them feel welcome.</p>	<p>Talk together about what things/people/places make you feel most welcome. <b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Luke 19:1-10 <b>DISCUSS:</b> What does this teach us about God?</p>
<p><b>WEEK 5</b> -----</p> <p>Jesus chose to be our sacrifice. What does this mean for me?</p>	<p><b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Isaiah 53:5 What is another word for "transgressions"?</p>	<p>Play checkers together. Talk about how you need to sacrifice some of your pieces in order to win.</p>	<p><b>1 PETER 5:7</b> How does Jesus demonstrate His care for us?</p>	<p>Sacrifice a relaxing afternoon by serving others in your community as a family.</p>	<p>Reenact the Last Supper as a family. <b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Matthew 26:1-5, 20-35 <b>DISCUSS:</b> What does this teach us about God?</p>
